

Gateway Players Theatre, Inc Bill Mastro Scholarship Criteria

1. All applicants must be a graduating senior, going on to college
2. All applicants must have participated in Gateway Players Theatre in some capacity
3. All applicants must provide a resume to include all Gateway Players Theatre shows they were involved in. (list roles and backstage jobs to include stage crew, lights, sound, makeup, costumes, props, set design and production or direction assistant)
4. All applicants must write an essay on “What Gateway Players Theatre has meant to me.”
5. All applicants should provide a list of arts involvement outside of Gateway Players, if applicable. (school chorus, drama clubs, band, etc.)

The scholarship will be awarded based on the following point system, also taking into account the essay and if necessary a personal interview.

50 points = all scholarship application information (essay, resume, attending college)

2 points = each year active in Gateway Players Theatre

2 points = per show for acting on stage

2 points = per show involved in backstage work (see list above)

5 points = if involved with an arts program outside of Gateway Players Theatre
